SMSC - The Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural development

- **Moral:** Recognise right and wrong; respect the civil and criminal law of England; understand consequences; investigate moral and ethical issues; offer reasoned views.
- **Social:** Use social skills in different contexts; work well with others; resolve conflicts; understand how communities work; contribute positively to life in modern Britain
- **Cultural:** Appreciate cultural influences; knowledge of Britain's democratic parliamentary system; participate in culture opportunities; understand, accept, respect and celebrate diversity.

At Sneinton, we constantly seek to promote the extensive personal development of pupils. Our pupils have access to a wide, rich set of experiences. Opportunities for pupils to develop their talents and interests are of exceptional quality. These rich experiences are planned in a coherent way and are delivered through both curriculum enrichment and Extra-Curricular Enrichment. There is strong take-up by all groups of pupils of the opportunities on offer.

All curriculum areas provide opportunities to promote students' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development. It is threaded throughout our school life. Some curriculum areas lend themselves more easily to evidencing direct SMSC development such as PSHE, RHE, RE, E-Safety etc. We also aim to develop SMSC through safeguarding across the curriculum, worship, behaviour expectations, school values and pupil leadership opportunities.

All these opportunities contribute to personal development and the development of our children's character development.

Provision for SMSC is monitored and reviewed on a regular basis, including impact through the use of our monitoring and evaluation cycle. We also track engagement of all groups of children in extra-curricular activities, ensuring that ALL have access to the offer, especially children eligible for pupil premium funding.
