



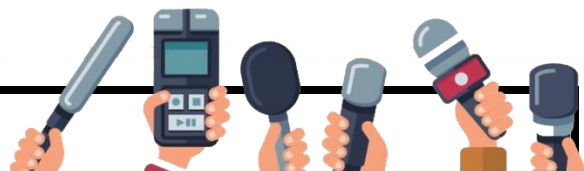

Year 1 and 4 Statutory Assessments

Over the next two weeks, Year 1 will complete the Phonics Screening Check and Year 4 will take the Multiplication Tables Check. These national assessments help us understand how well children are securing key skills in reading and maths.

They'll be completed in a calm, supportive way, and we know our children will approach them with the enthusiasm and effort they show every day.

We're already proud of them and all they've achieved this year!



E-Scooter Safety Reminder

We kindly remind all families that privately owned electric scooters are illegal to use on public roads, pavements, and cycle paths. They are classified as motor vehicles under UK law, requiring insurance and a valid driving licence—conditions that currently cannot be met.

Therefore, children should not travel to school on electric scooters or bring them onto school premises. Using an e-scooter illegally can result in a £300 fine or the scooter being seized by the authorities.

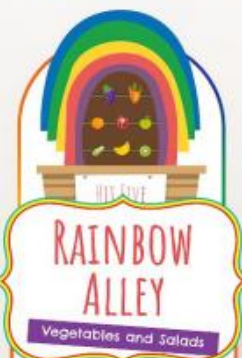

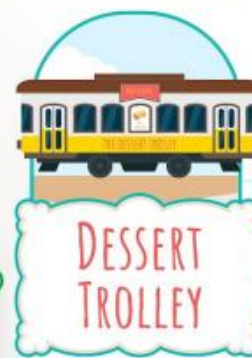
