We have been able to create our own detailed stencils and have used toothbrushes to make a spray effect. Perhaps we have a future Banksy or two in our midst!



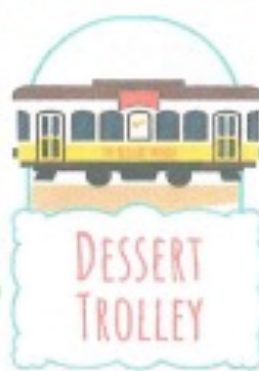
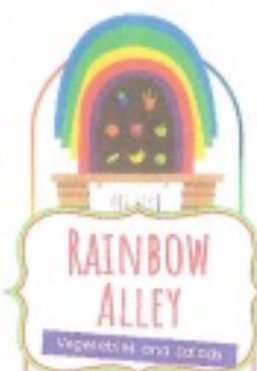
