The Poetry Fairy also paid a visit to each class, leaving behind a special poem for students to discover and explore, sparking joy and inspiring creative thinking.

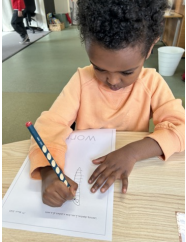

Year 6

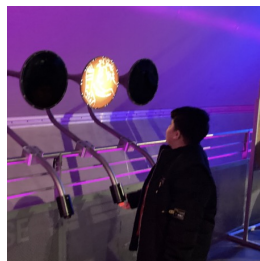
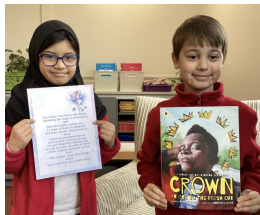
